- 1.- Open gvSIG
- 2.- Add new View (EPSG 23030)
- 3.- Add new layer http://downloads.gvsig.org/download/geodata/vector/KML/Huesca_SITAR_KML.zip
- 4.- Select properties and apply EPSG 4326, click in transformation.
- 5.- You can check that the Huesca.kml is not reproject well to EPSG 23030
'In gvSIG 1.11 it works fine'

 - 2.- Abrir nueva Vista (EPSG 23030)
 - 3.- Añadir capa http://downloads.gvsig.org/download/geodata/vector/KML/Huesca_SITAR_KML.zip
 - 4.- Seleccionar en propiedades y aplicar EPSG 4326, seleccionar transformación
 - 5.- Se puede observar que Huesca.kml no se reprojecta bien a EPSG 23030
