- 4.- Add other new layer shp (<http://downloads.gvsig.org/download/geodata/vector/SHP2D/faceros.navarra.zip>)
- 5.- Select the two layers in Toc
- 6.- Click right button
- 7.- Select 'Group layers'
- 8.- The layers are group, but appears a message to warning and gvSIG works slow, the message persist
