I think that the problem is the icon used. The tool can be used to select by point or by rectangle, so I don't think we need another tool.

We could use a simple arrow icon (as we did on 1.x versions), then it would be clearer that it is a generic selection tool. Lots of programs use a simple arrow (the classical pointer icon) for the generic selection tool that works both as select by point and select by rectangle.
