I was opening a ticket about it, when I have found this. :)

The server URL is absolutely not necessary in the ToC. For instance, consider a server with a long URL which serves different layers. **First issue:** the progress bar is not readable when loading a WFS layer. **Second issue:** once loaded two or more layers from the same server, the user has to enlarge the ToC to understand the layer names. **Third issue:** other OGC services skip the URL from layer name in the ToC yet.
