#### Description

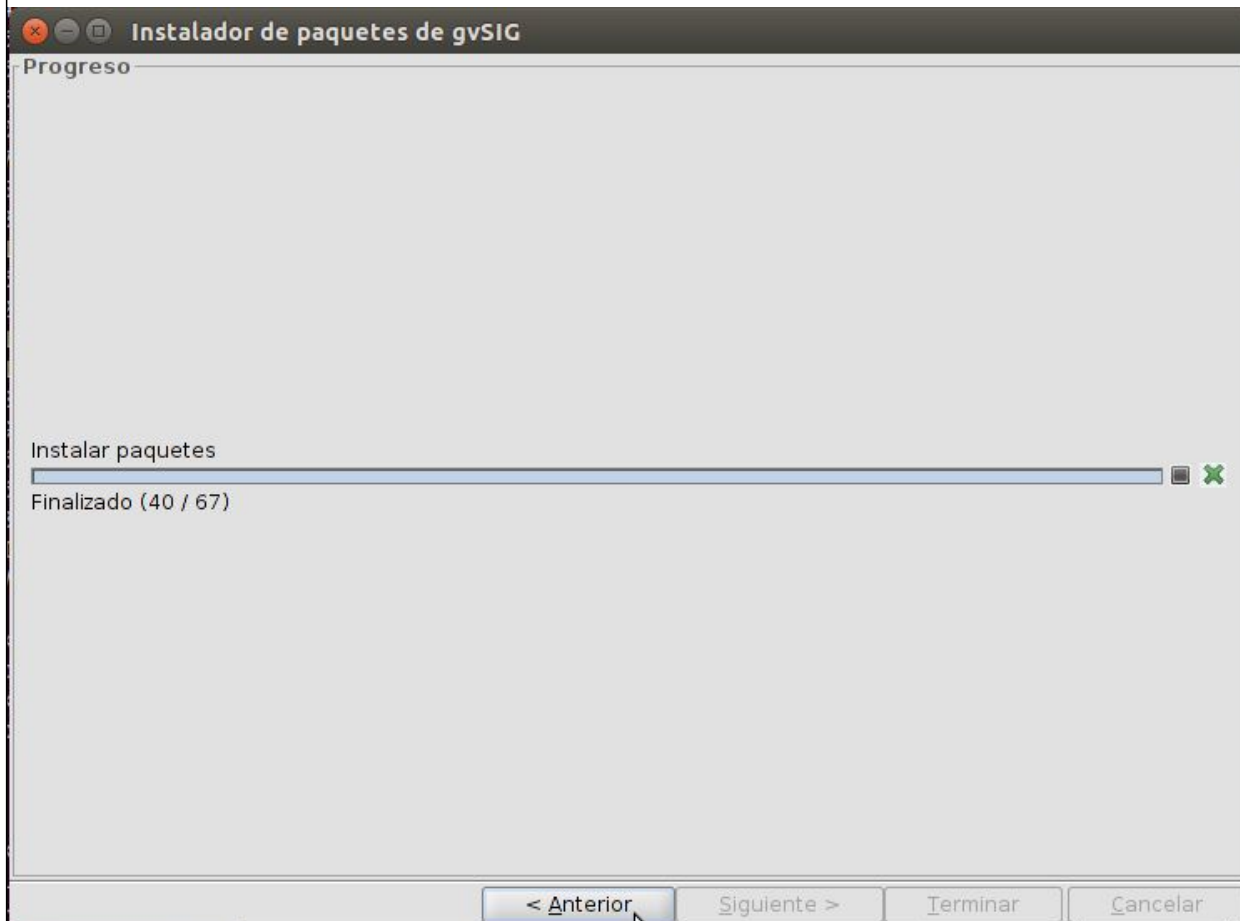
I have downloaded the 2.1 build 2245 installer for linux 64 bits from:

The installation begins as expected: I select Spanish as language, accept license and select **Standard installation**.

Next I select **Typical installation** and in the next step the package installation process starts installing each package.

At one point it says **Finalizado** but the number of installed packages is less than the total, and the **Siguiente** button is not active, so installation could not end nor be canceled, as you can see in the following image:



I can go to the previous step and try again, but it stops again at another random position or zero.

Haven't tested in other platforms.
