SEXTANTE "Union" returns "only" the **intersection** between the two layers. Update the title, please.

The differences between layer1 (layer 2) and intersection are missing because of a "Value null not allowed for the attribute..." error. The differences generate records where some cell are null and this doesn't like to DefaultFeature in DAL. So it's a gvSIG issue, not a Geoprocesses one.
