instead I attach a screenshot relative to your same conditions, but after a fresh install (removing the gvSIG home folder), showing clearly that the "jCRS EPSG: version 8.8" package is still not available in the Testing gvSIG repository.

Note that the "jCRS EPSG: version 8.8" package is available in your screenshot because it's loaded from the jCRS extension folder, but not from the repository.

the "jCRS EPSG: version 8.8" package is available now, thanks! The only strangeness I can see is that its version is 1.0.0-2 (instead of 1.0.0-1, like the previous ones), so two minor versions of the same jCRS EPSG package are shown in the Addons Manager after restarting gvSIG. Is there some particular reason? Is it possible to downgrade the minor version of the package in order to show only one?
