**Description**

It's not possible to restore the classic icon-theme from *General | Icon theme* preferences, once installed the TReCC ones. The dropdown list contains only the TReCC icon-themes.

The only way to restore it consists into deleting the icon-theme folders from *gvSIG/icon-theme* (user directory) manually.
