Description

Follow this steps:

1. Load a multi-line shape in a view
2. Start editing mode
3. Select tree geometries by rectangle
4. Select Symmetry tool
5. Click the first point
6. Click the second point
7. Answer N to remove original geometry

The result is:

1. Just one of tree geometries copied.
2. Mouse curse is set to *working* and application doesn't receive mouse events (keyboard still working in editing console).
3. No way to make anything but close application (by clicking in window close button)
